



Dear colleagues, friends and visitors of Dignity.cat

I would like to update you about Dignity.cat during my stay in Kenya and few additional information.

- I met with the kids of the program, visited them in their homes and in the school
- Total money we had up to the beginning of September was 2520€, and with this:
- we renewed the contract of the teacher who has been contracted to improve the teaching staff level.
- we have included 10 children more in the programme, now we have a total of 31 children, we have 19 kids in the urgent waiting list
- we supported the construction of the 4th class room for the secondary section with 500€
- we have initiated the latrine project for elderly people with reduced mobility, we hope to have 4 pilot latrines ready by December
- we started to support with cash the families that we considered highly vulnerable to ensure the children are maintained in the school and very basic needs are covered
- we have started a cash allowance motivation for the Dignity Katuk CBO volunteers to ensure support and quality follow up of the program.
- we distributed six walking sticks the elderly and a wheelchair to mama Margaret.

I was accompanied with 3 couples who combined their Safari holiday trip to Kenya with a three day stay in Katuk to see the programme. It was good trip and the kids had a great time with the visitors.

NOTE: The kids are doing well interns of health and social welfare, BUT: We want to follow them very closely on their school and of education progress, many of them are around or below average, we know why this is like this as they have been in very unstable situation.

This month 3/10/2018 we have the General Assembly of the organisation where we will review many things including funding strategy, reflect on what we have done, priorities for the coming year etc.
